**This Trial is being offered on cattle and sheep. There will be 8 cattle runs and 12 sheep runs available. Entries open July 7<sup>th</sup>. Pre entries close August 4<sup>th</sup>. This trial is not recommended for physically challenged individuals.**

**There is a lot of real estate to cover to complete this trial. A horse or 4 wheeler can be used if desired, but you will need to bring your own. If used to push cattle, your score will reflect that. We are requesting a 30 minute time limit due to distance cattle must go. Sheep time limit will be 20 minutes.**

**PreEntries Sheep \$45, cattle \$55 Day of if available \$55, \$65**

NO PRE-ENTRIES ACCEPTED PRIOR TO A POSTMARK DATE OF July 7th, 2014.

PRE-ENTRIES MUST BE POSTMARKED BY August 4th, 2014 – Entries must have clearly visible USPS postmark. No meter mail allowed. No DHL. UPS, telephone, email, faxed entries will be accepted. Overnight entries accepted only if signature is waived. Incomplete entry forms including registration numbers and entries will NOT be accepted. Please make sure your entry form includes the dog's call name and your e-mail address. Registered owner of dog must submit entry check with their name on the check & send a copy of the dogs registration/tracking # form showing registered owner with the entry form. Checks will be deposited on August 5th. Insufficient funded checks will be charged a \$50. Fee, and runs granted to next contestant on waiting list.

Day of entries accepted (if available) until 7:30 am when Handlers Meeting Starts

## DRIVING DIRECTIONS TO FREE TO BE RANCH

Mountainair is located 60 miles south east of Albuquerque. The ranch is 30 minutes from either Interstate 40 or from Interstate 25. The ranch is 1/2 mile off Hwy 60 on Curandera Road - Curandera Road is between mile marker 208 & 209 on Hwy 60.

### **DIRECTIONS FROM INTERSTATE 40 IN NEW MEXICO:**

- Take exit 196 in Moriarty, go south on Hwy 41 until it dead ends into Hwy 60
- Take a right (west) onto Hwy 60 - go approximately 7 miles on Hwy 60
- On Hwy 60 go 1/2 mile past mile marker 209 to County Road BO 46
- Turn right (North) onto County Road BO 46 - We are the first ranch on your left

### **DIRECTIONS FROM INTERSTATE 25 IN NEW MEXICO:**

- Take Exit 175 in Bernardo, go east on Hwy 60
- Go thru blinking light in the town of Mountainair (we are about 4 1/2 miles from the light)
- On Hwy 60 go 1/2 mile past mile marker 208 to County Road BO 46
- Turn left (North) onto County Road BO 46 - we are the first ranch on your left

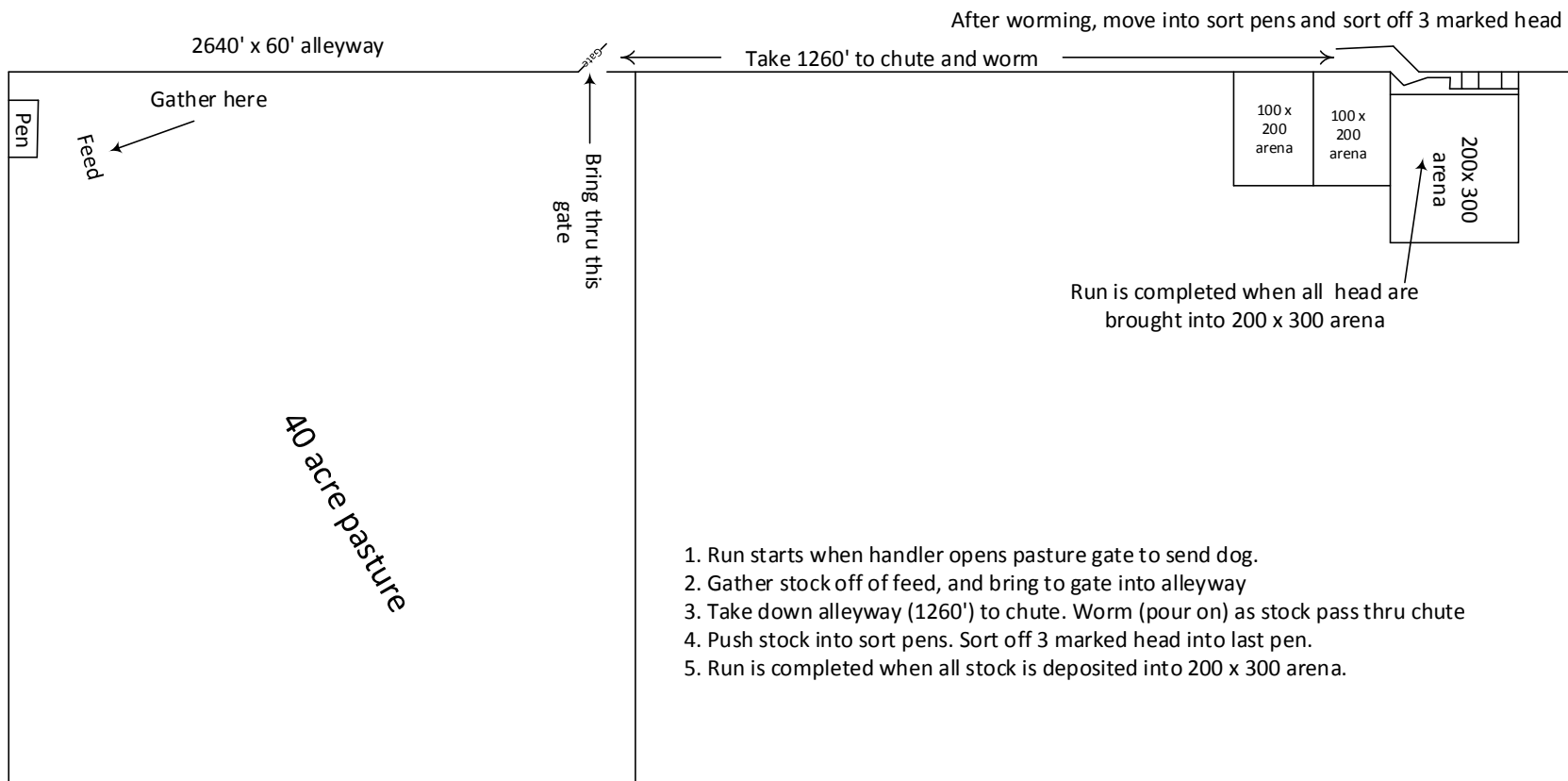

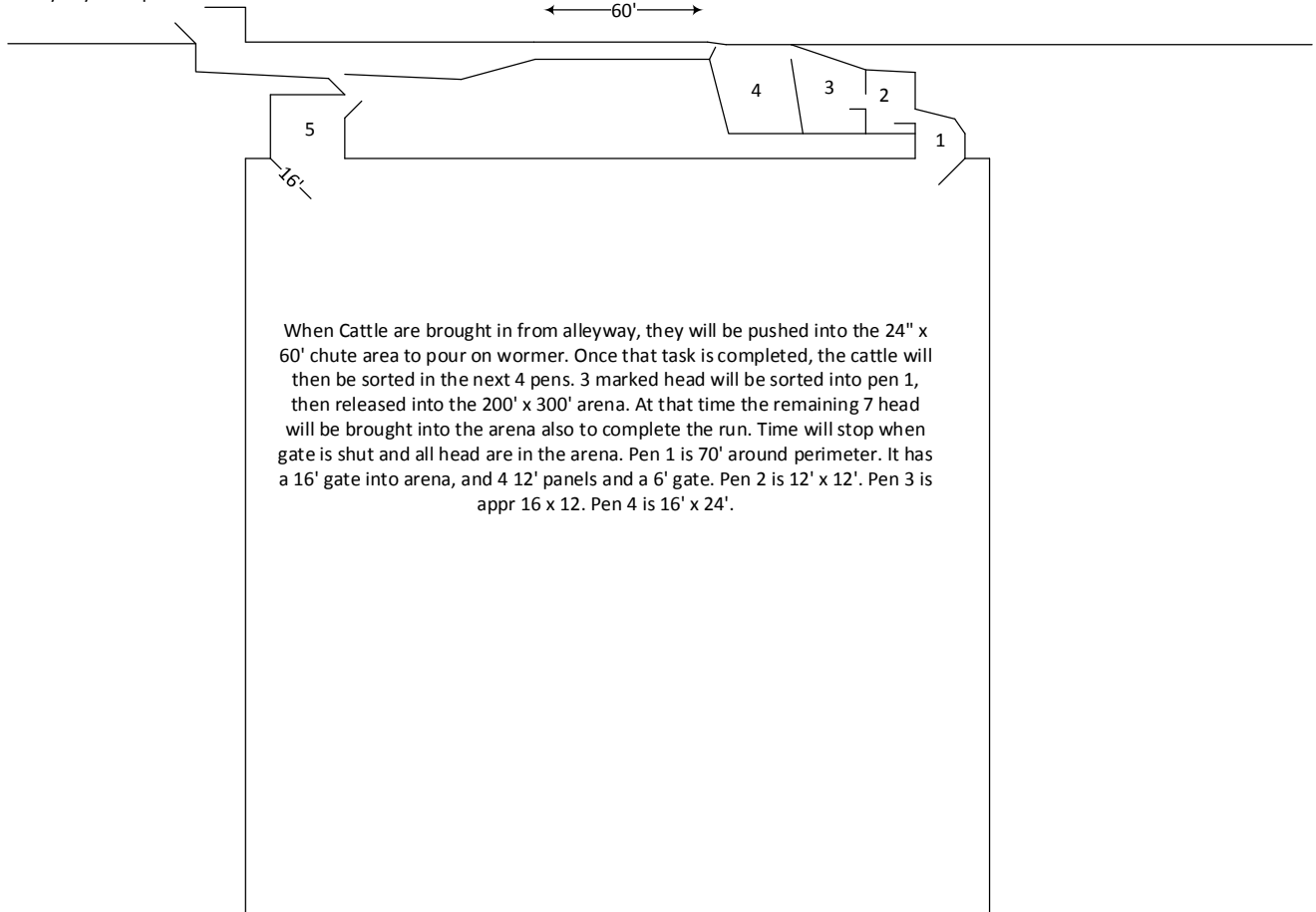


1. Run starts when handler opens pasture gate to send dog.
2. Gather stock off of feed, and bring to gate into alleyway
3. Take down alleyway (1260') to chute. Worm (pour on) as stock pass thru chute
4. Push stock into sort pens. Sort off 3 marked head into last pen.
5. Run is completed when all stock is deposited into 200 x 300 arena.

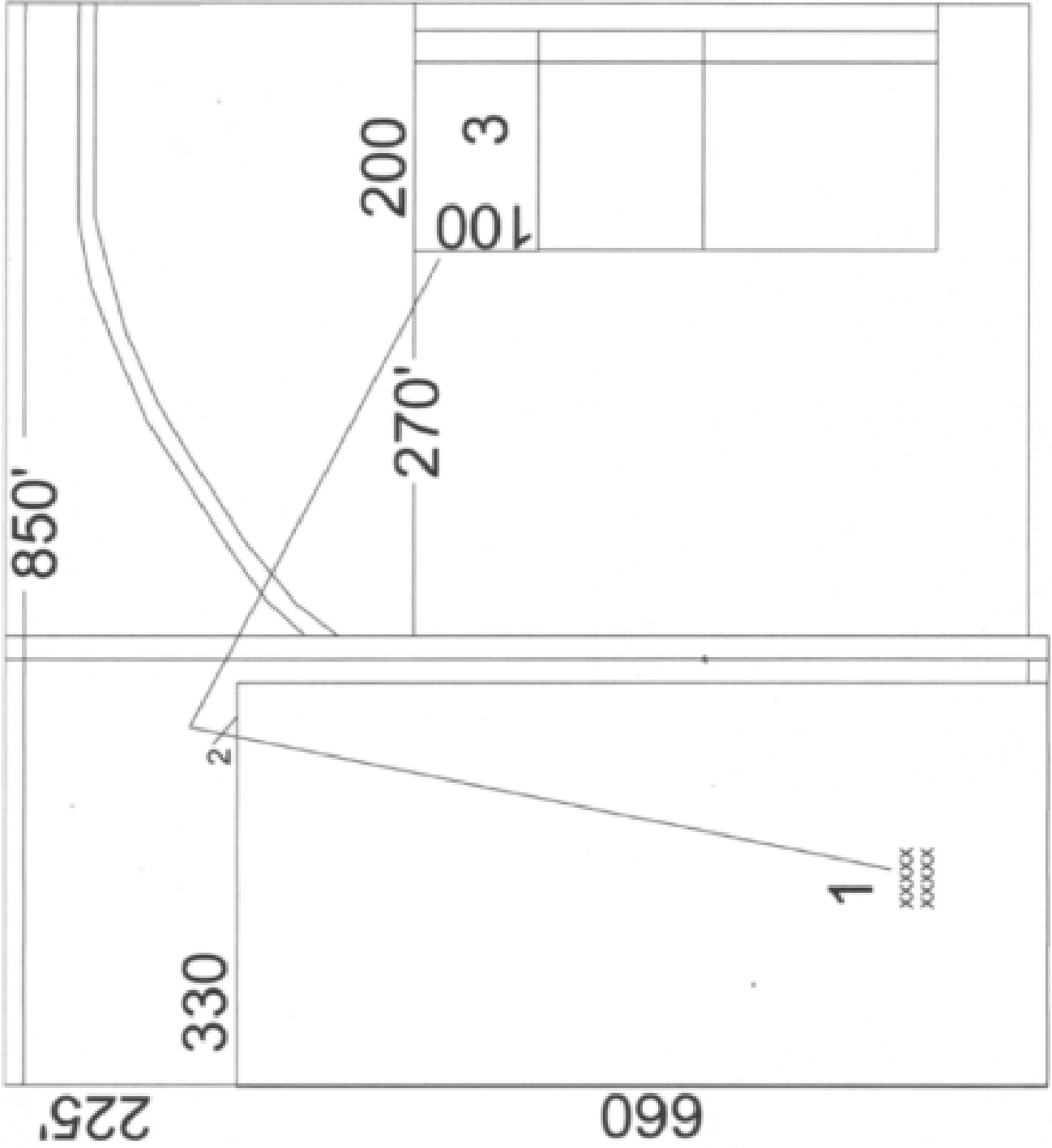
Alleyway from pasture

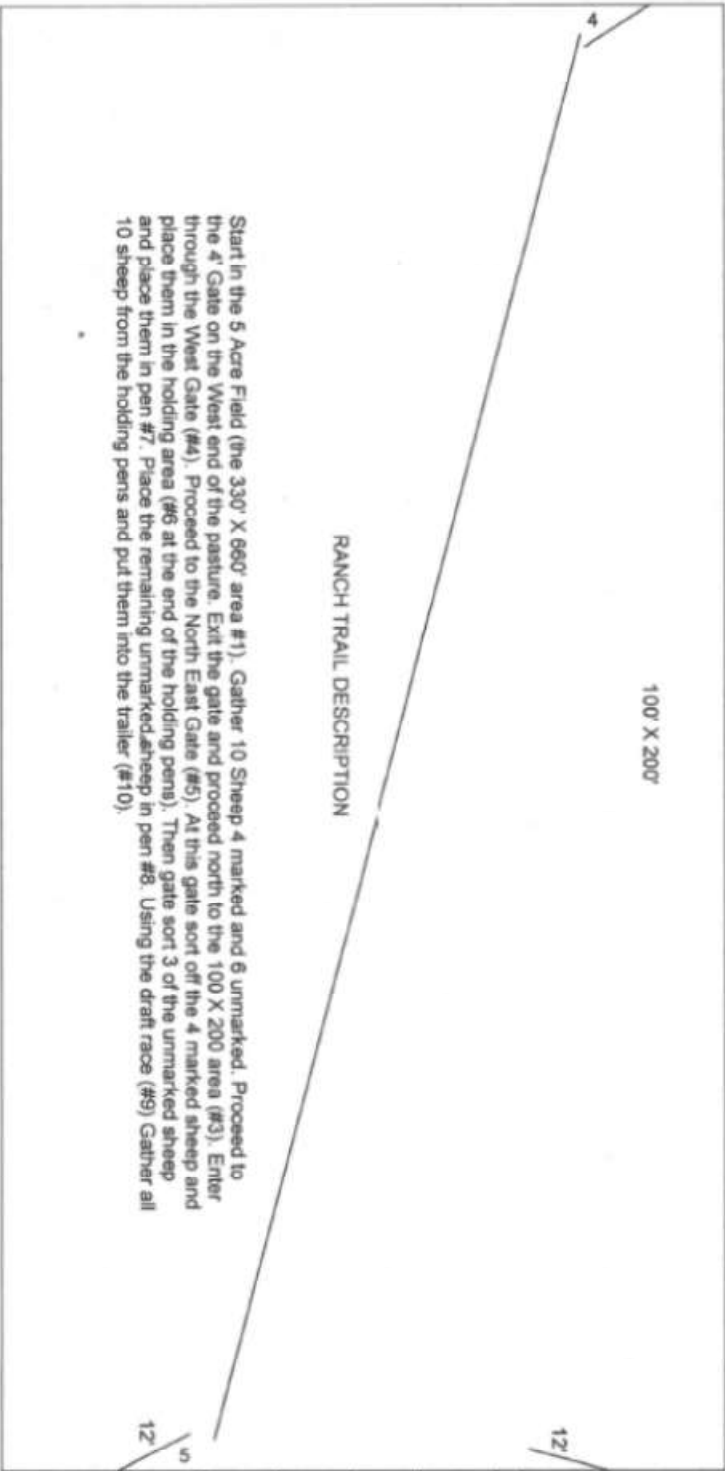


When Cattle are brought in from alleyway, they will be pushed into the 24" x 60' chute area to pour on wormer. Once that task is completed, the cattle will then be sorted in the next 4 pens. 3 marked head will be sorted into pen 1, then released into the 200' x 300' arena. At that time the remaining 7 head will be brought into the arena also to complete the run. Time will stop when gate is shut and all head are in the arena. Pen 1 is 70' around perimeter. It has a 16' gate into arena, and 4 12' panels and a 6' gate. Pen 2 is 12' x 12'. Pen 3 is appr 16 x 12. Pen 4 is 16' x 24'.

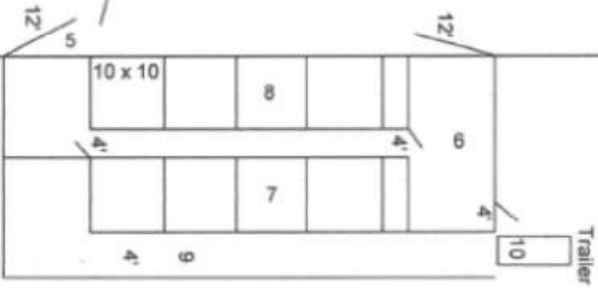

RANCH TRAIL DESCRIPTION

Start in the 5 Acre Field (the 330' X 660' area #1). Gather 10 Sheep 4 marked and 6 unmarked. Proceed to the 4' Gate on the West end of the pasture. Exit the gate and proceed north to the 100 X 200 area (#3). Enter through the West Gate (#4). Proceed to the North East Gate (#5). At this gate sort off the 4 marked sheep and place them in the holding area (#6 at the end of the holding pens). Then gate sort 3 of the unmarked sheep and place them in pen #7. Place the remaining unmarked sheep in pen #8. Using the draft race (#9) Gather all 10 sheep from the holding pens and put them into the trailer (#10).
